## Invited Speakers



### **Professor Paul Abrams MD, FRCS**

Professor Abrams is Director of the Bristol Urological Institute and one of the world's leading experts in the field of lower urinary tract dysfunction. He is Professor of Urology at the University of Bristol, and Consultant Urological Surgeon at Southmead Hospital. The third edition of his book "Urodynamics" was published in 2005 and the 4th edition of "Incontinence" which he co-edits, in 2009. He is founder of the ICI-RS, an international research society, which had its inaugural meeting in Bristol in May 2009.



### **Professor Kesavan Esuvaranathan MBBS, FRCSEd, FRCSG, FAMS (Urol), MD**

Professor Kesavan Esuvaranathan is a Senior Consultant and Clinical Director, Urology Centre, Department of Urology National University Hospital, Singapore. He is also Professor at the National University Singapore and Director of Research in the Department of Surgery. He is the leading researcher for the Bladder Cancer Workgroup, investigating immunotherapies for bladder cancer, including gene therapy. He is also Editor of Asian Urology and a reviewer for Cancer, Cancer Research, Journal of Urology & Urology.

He has been won 12 research awards in the past ten years and has multiple articles in peer reviewed Journals.



### **Professor Gordon McLorie MD, FAAP, FRCSC**

Gordon McLorie MD is currently a professor of urology in Wake Forest University School of Medicine where he is a lead investigator with, Professor Anthony Atala, of a study of bladder replacement surgery, utilising the bladder constructs, developed in the laboratory at Wake Forest Institute of Regenerative Medicine. He is the author of more than 200 Scientific articles, and book chapters.
