Invited Speakers

Mark Soloway, MD



Mark Soloway, MD, is currently a professor in the Department of Urology at the University of Miami Miller School of Medicine. He was the chair of the department from 1991 to 2010. His residency in urology was in Cleveland, Ohio, at University Hospitals of Cleveland (CaseWestern ReserveUniversity). He had a fellowship at the surgery branch of the National Cancer Institute/National Institutes of Health. His research involved the development of an animal model for bladder cancer. Using this model he found that the investigational antitumor agent cisdiamminedichloroplatinum (now cisplatin) was effective in dramatically reducing tumor growth. This accelerated the use of this in patients with locally advanced and metastatic bladder cancer. Some 30 years later cisplatin is still the most effective drug for this cancer.

During his residency Dr. Soloway maintained an experimental laboratory and using animal models he demonstrated that tumor implantation preferentially occurred on an altered urothelial surface. He suggested that intravesical chemotherapy should be used following an endoscopic tumor resection to reduce the recurrence rate. Subsequent randomized trials confirmed the benefit of this approach.

Dr. Soloway has been active in research involving prostate cancer as well. He has published extensively on the technical aspects of performing a radical prostatectomy.

These articles deal with bladder neck preservation, nerve sparing, the consequence of positive margins and an adverse Gleason score. He also has detailed the outcome of a large group of men who have elected initial active surveillance.

Dr. Soloway received the Gold Cystoscope Award in 1984. He was honored with the President's Award by the American Urological Association for his career achievements in research and in fostering his style of case discussion conferences. Dr. Soloway has authored more than 500 articles in peer reviewed journals as well as over 50 book chapters. He has been a visiting professor at a number of major medical centers as well as at many national urology meetings.

Manish Patel



A/Prof Patel is a uro-oncologist at Westmead Hospital, Sydney Australia and an academic in the discipline of surgery, the University of Sydney. A/Prof Patel graduated from the University of NSW in 1991. He undertook his residency and general surgery training at the Royal North Shore Hospital. He then completed a Masters of Medicine (USYD) in cell biology and protein biochemistry followed by his FRACS in Urology. Following Urology Training, A/Prof Patel completed a 2 year Uro- Oncology Fellowship at Memorial Sloan-Kettering Cancer Center, New York. He also completed a PhD on novel therapies for prostate cancer.

Since 2003 A/Prof Patel has practiced Uro-oncology exclusively at Westmead and Sydney Adventist Hospital. His special interests clinically are the management of Prostate and Bladder Cancer.

A/Prof Patel is the director of the Urological Cancer Outcomes Centre, University of Sydney, scientific director of the Urological Cancer Organisation of Western Sydney, Chair of the ANZUP bladder cancer trials committee, Urological representative to the board of surgical research for the Royal Australasian College of Surgeons, Australia NZ representative to the AUA International committee, a leader of the uro-oncology

special advisory group of the Urological Society of Australia and New Zealand, chair of the education committee for the Urological Oncology Program of NSW, co-ordinator of urological teaching and chair of medical student assessments, University of Sydney.
